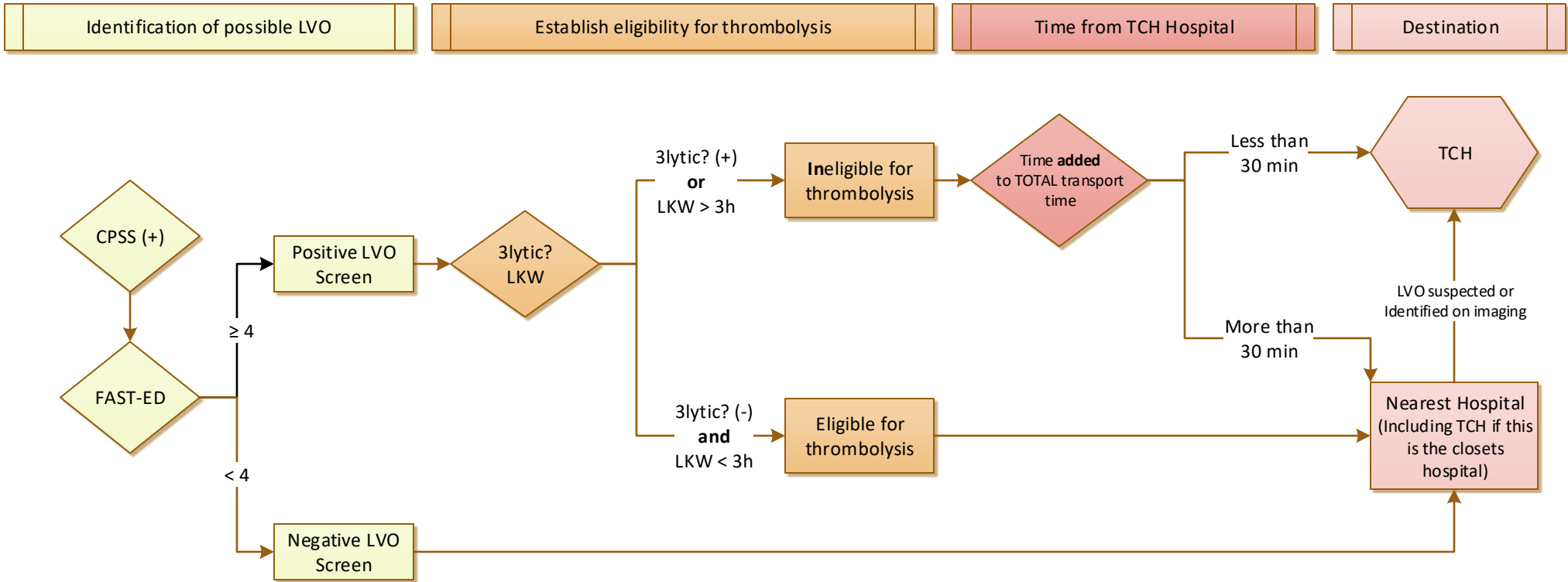


STROKE TRIAGE ALGORITHM FOR MAINE EMS



- 3lytic? = 3 Thrombolytic Eligibility Questions**
- Have you had any trauma, surgeries or procedures within the last 3 months?
 - Do you have any history of abnormal bleeding?
 - Are you taking any blood thinners?

If the pt answers yes to any of these questions, Clarify "what" and "when"

- Patient ineligible for thrombolysis:**
- Severe head trauma within 3 months
 - Intracranial or intra-spinal surgery within 3 months
 - Major non-cranial surgery or trauma within 14 days with uncontrollable bleeding site (e.g. internal organs)
 - History of spontaneous (non-traumatic) intracranial hemorrhage
 - Structural GI malignancy or GI bleeding within 21 days
 - Actively taking blood thinners

- Common blood thinners:**
- warfarin (Coumadin or Jantoven)
 - heparin or LMWH (Lovenox)
 - dabigatran (Pradaxa)
 - rivaroxaban (Xarelto)
 - apixaban (Eliquis)
 - betrixaban (Bevyxxa)
 - edoxaban (Savaysa)

LVO = Large vessel occlusion
TCH = Thrombectomy Capable Hospital
LKW = Last Known Well

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
